The Pentagram

A Pentagram is a 5 pointed star, and one of the most common items used or displayed. Sometimes carved in wood, other times forged in metal and worn as jewelry. It represents Good Luck and is also used for Protection.

Make a Journal Note: What else does the Pentagram represent?

NEED:

-- a cardboard circle or a wooden circle (any size will do)

-- a star stencil or a wooden star to use or

trace (the star should fit inside the circle)



This is one of the easiest tools to make. Simply draw a star in a clockwise direction (going to the right) with a pencil. Now you can use markers to color it, you can paint it (fabric paint works really well), you can wood burn your design, or glue a star onto your circle. (see above image for ideas)

ABOVE ALL - MAKE IT YOUR OWN!

Consecrating your Pentagram... Have a PARENT light some incense of your choice...maybe it's your favorite or an incense that corresponds with the purpose of your creation. Now hold your creation in your hands and hold it out in front of you. **NOW PARENTS: CAREFULLY** pass the incense smoke over and around your child's hands and creation while **THEY** say something like:

I made this with my two hands,
With purest thoughts to serve me well.
So it shall be! (or) So mote it be!
