The Following Lyrics are sung to: “POP! goes the Weasel”

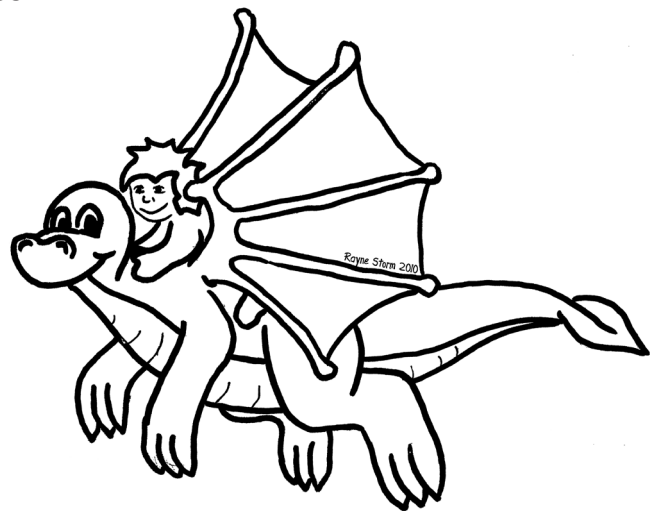
Song 3: “adjusted” to sing and play with dragon
